New Campbellford Skate Park Receives Support from Ontario Trillium Foundation

Trent Hills, ON – Today, Northumberland/Quinte-West MPP Lou Rinaldi is pleased to announce a grant of \$40,000 from the Ontario Trillium Foundation for the new Campbellford Skate Park.

Through the leadership of the Municipality of Trent Hills and the Trent Hills Skate Park Committee partnerships have been formed and plans have been developed for the construction of a new concrete skate park to be located Kennedy Park. The facility will provide opportunities for area children and youth to skateboard, bike and roller blade.
