TRENT HILLS, ON: This statement is in response to the unfortunate event that took place at the Campbellford Legion over the weekend when an inappropriate costume was recognized. Though I do not wish to give this incident or the individuals responsible any additional exposure, I feel the need to speak out on behalf of the Municipality of Trent Hills. Offensive behavior such as this is not acceptable and is in no way condoned by the Municipality, its Council and staff. I am shocked and saddened that this incident occurred in Trent Hills.

Trent Hills is a truly welcoming place to live and visit, which makes the offensive actions of these individuals even more unfortunate and disappointing. We remain a friendly community that values diversity and openness. In my two terms as Mayor and as a lifelong Trent Hills resident, I have never known of such a tasteless or appalling incident. The unacceptable actions of these two individuals is in no way representative of Trent Hills and should not be reflected back on this wonderful community or the Royal Canadian Legion.
