Hastings Waterfront Park & Beach Official Opening

Trent Hills, ON – The Municipality of Trent Hills and the Hastings Marina Management Committee invite the press and public to join in celebrating the official opening and dedication of the Hastings Waterfront Improvement Project involving the parkland and beach area on the south shore at the Hastings Village Marina.

As phase 1 of the Hastings Downtown and Waterfront Improvement Plan, this rehabilitation project includes extensive landscaping improvements to the park area as well as the public beach. The project features new trees, flower beds, decorative rock, an interlocking brick walking path, improved seating areas, new sand at the beach and improvements to the boat launch and parking lot areas. This initiative was completed in partnership between the Municipality of Trent Hills, the Hastings Hydro Board and the Hastings Revitalization Association.

The Hastings Village Marina park and beach area is now officially open to the public and all are encouraged to use this beautiful parkland. “The improvements made to the Hastings waterfront demonstrate how community partners coming together can make a really big difference and completely revitalize a public space. It’s our hope that the new and improved beach and park area will be enjoyed by all and get lots of use this summer” remarked Mayor Hector Macmillan.
