# CAMPBELLFORD SKATEPARK

**Specifications:** • Street area - 3,850 sq. ft. • Bowl - 2,550 sq. ft.

This park is a sculptural beauty and tons of fun! The faux stone, the gorgeous concrete sign, and the suspended hubba ledge; not to mention the gorgeous lines in the bowl and flow zone of the street area make this a feast for the eyes ... not to mention the wheels!

The streetscape zone combines plaza flavour with lots of flow, including a crazy roller/taco, a long flat ledge/manny, a flatbar, flatbank hip, large hubbas and rail down a 3 flat 3 double set, a step up, high bump to rail, low bump to rail, bump to upledge, beginner hubbas and rail down a bank, and medium hubbas and rail down 4, bump to ledges and more. The central landscaped area assists with drainage and facilitates a great "circle flow" at this park.

The bowl could well be Canada's most unique bowl. It's small, but just packed with unique stuff including the loveseat, the mechanical to pool style corner that blends its' tranny from regular to "pool tight" through the corner, the steep bank extension, the constantly escalating deep end, and of course the big rollout hip to mini qp up on the deck. This skates like a dream and is being frequented by rippers from Toronto and Ottawa.
